

Below is a quick legend to the grid of statistical information inside the query:

Game, Pitcher Name, Hitter Name, Balls, Strikes, Outs and Inning are all pretty obvious. Here's a list of the rest:

Pitch count = That pitcher's numbered pitch.

Speed = Jugs Radar Gun. Note: Pitch speeds were not recorded in Games 1&2

ROB = Runners on Base

In Zone = True equals YES it was recorded in the strike zone regardless of what the umpire called; False equals NO it was not recorded in the strike zone.

Overturns = was not working during area code games; but it shows videos of bad calls (in the strike zone but called a ball and visa versa)

PLoc – This represents the zone locations 1-9

InningHalf – T stands for Top Half of Inning and B stands for Bottom Half of Inning
